This Safety Alert aims to inform MTS staff and contractors about updates regarding the competency prerequisites for Protection Officer 2 and Protection Officer 4 operating within the MTS Network.

For the context of MTS Protection Officer competencies, the MTS Network encompasses any area where MTS holds accreditation as the Rail Transport Operator (RTO) and the Rail Infrastructure Manager (RIM).

Effective from **14 June 2024**, MTS staff and contractors are only permitted to undertake Protection Officer responsibilities within the MTS Network if they hold either the MTS Protection Officer Level 2 and/or MTS Protection Officer Level 4 job role.

Note:

Staff and contractors designated as MTS Protection Officer 2 and/or 4 are not authorised to perform Protection Officer duties outside the MTS Network unless they obtain approval from the relevant Rail Transport Operator, as they may have additional business requirements.

Action required:

- MTS Protection Officer 2 or 4 job roles must be assigned to the workers RIW card
- This must be completed by 14 June 2024.
